**BRIEF DESCRIPTION:** Washes and stores properly all dishes, trays, eating utensils, cups, and small equipment for the department. Maintains the dish room and dish machine in a sanitary and efficient manner.

**PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Set up and breaks down dish machine, including arms, screens, and baskets. Cleans and polishes machine thoroughly including removing any paper and hosing down interior. Checks machine to be sure it is operating correctly and reports any defect immediately. Washes and stores in proper places all dishes, trays, utensils, cups, and small equipment for the department. Checks water temperature during dishwashing operation to ensure proper temperature. Report if temperature is not being met and switch to liquid sanitizer.
- Removes trash from dish room and places in dumpster. Clean and sanitize garbage cans and keeps clean liners in cans at all times.
- Cleans and keeps neat dish room area including detergent storage area.
- Reports to E wing on the breakfast shift. Reports to F wing on the evening meal shift.
- Advises the Director of Foodservice and/or designee of any potential or actual problem which may jeopardize Albright Care Services.
- Maintains a courteous, professional relationship with all other organization staff.
- Recognizes confidential matters and does not divulge confidential information or material to anyone not authorized to receive such information.
- Other duties as assigned by the Foodservice Director and/or designee.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Ability to communicate in the primary language(s) used in the workplace desirable.
- Must be able to pass a physical examination within State and Federal guidelines.
- Must have at least a 10<sup>th</sup> grade education.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:**

- Subject to wet floors, temperature extremes and loud noise.
- Must be able to bend, stoop, lift and carry dish racks weighing up to 40 pounds on a regular and continuing basis.
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time and move from area to area in the kitchen.
